

## **Vermont Dual Enrollment Program**

This program allows Vermont residents who are publicly funded high school students access to college credit-bearing courses while receiving high school and college credit.

Under the Flexible Pathways Initiative (Act 77), Dual Enrollment:

- Offers up to two tuition-free courses (using dual enrollment vouchers) for eligible Vermont students who are juniors or seniors in a high school, CTE Center or the Home Study Program (home study students must have an enrollment notice on file at the Agency of Education to be eligible for vouchers)
- Offers courses at 19 participating colleges/universities in Vermont
- Provides up to four credits per course
- Students pay for textbooks, lab and materials fees
- Students must apply and be approved for a voucher through the voucher system at [www.vtdualenrollment.org](http://www.vtdualenrollment.org)
